



## 2SD71 Professional Learning Plan 2019-2020

*This document is intended to be a flexible plan, with the understanding that your professional needs and interests may change over the course of the year. First and foremost, it is a plan for you, to consider and reflect on your practice and identify areas you wish to grow in or experiment with.*

August 27 & 28 2019 have been set aside as PD days, but are not mandatory, giving you flexibility to choose other PD events during the summer or the school year to meet the requirement of 10 hours (for 2 days FTE).

**Note: these are in addition to the Provincial PD day in October and our District PD day in February.**

➔ **You need to complete 10 hours of Pro-D activities before February 28, 2020 in order to be paid for your Pro-D days in the March 2020 (spring break) pay period.**

The purpose of this form is to help you articulate your vision for your personal professional learning for the year in order to complete your flex days of 10 hours of PD.

**\*\*If you choose to participate in PD activities on August 27 & 28, then you simply check off your time as “completed” in the first section of the form and record the sessions you attended.**

Professional Learning activities can take many forms, including, but not limited to:

- Professional inquiry around a topic with colleagues;
- reading professional books—either independently or as part of a book club;
- taking courses or webinars;
- attending afterschool sessions provided by the District, CSTs or an LSA (Local Specialist Association);
- attending a conference or workshop

**Once you have completed your plan you need to make 2 copies:**

- 1 copy for your administrator and
- 1 copy for your Pro-D school rep to submit to the PD chair

**Keep the original for yourself. Deadline for submission is September 30, 2019.**
